“Weinwanderung” July 15th

Stuttgart has a very unique landmark - the so called STÄFFELE, „ little flights of steps“, the stairs which date back to the days of winegrowing.

Long ago, when most of the hills close to the city center were used as vineyards and gardens, those stairs had been used by winegrowers to climb up the hills. Miles and miles of those stairs provided a steep, yet quick connection between each of the hills within the city, thus avoiding long detours even now.



We will explore some of the “Stäffele” on our tour on Saturday July 15th. You can participate on a wine walk near Degerloch on the hills and vineyards near the city center.
